**Acceptance Criteria**

Participants in IOIA Advanced Inspector Training courses must meet course acceptance criteria, including prior completion of two inspector training courses and 2 years inspection experience with at least 20 inspections or 1 year inspection experience with at least 30 inspections. Requests for exceptions to the requirements should be addressed to the IOIA Executive Director.
